



### Changes are coming to the Quadra Island Recycling Depot

The Comox Strathcona waste management (CSWM) service would like to inform residents that the region's recycling depots will be changing to make it easier for people to recycle.

The changes will apply to the recycling depot located on Quadra Island. This depot, along with other depots located in Campbell River, will transition to "single-stream" recycling similar to the municipal curbside recycling program.

"We are making it easy to recycle," said Jesse Lee, CSWM's manager of operations. "Residents will not have to sort their recyclables into separate collection bins, simply place all recyclables into one of the bins. Emterra our contractor will take care of the sorting at their recycling facility."

This past week, the Quadra depot was changed out to the new format that includes replacing the bins and updating signage. Residents will also notice changes for glass recycling. The glass bin previously in place will soon be removed and residents are encouraged to return their refundable bottles for refund, and to recycle their other glass in Campbell River at the Island Return-It Depot (1580 Willow Street, Campbell River) or at the Campbell River waste management centre (6200 Argonaut Road, Campbell River). These recycling depots are part of a provincial program that accepts glass for recycling. The glass bins previously provided at the Quadra depot were not part of the provincial MMBC glass recycling program which lead to landfilling these materials in the Campbell River landfill for the past several years.

Glass recycling in British Columbia is very challenging and few options exist outside of the approved depots described above. Taking glass to the Campbell River recycling depots will help keep this recyclable product out of our regional landfills.

Barrie Agar, head gardener at Hatley Park National Historic Site at Royal Roads in Victoria, will be the guest speaker at the Garden Club meeting on Monday, September 12th, 7 pm at the Community Centre. #### I sent this to the chief administrative officer of the CVRD:

I read in Jim Abram's Regional Director's Report (July 22 issue of the Discovery Islander, from Quadra) that the district Waste Committee has decided on a policy that is tragically regressive.

Dumping our previously sorted materials into one container to be hauled away and sorted by hand again is some kind of ridiculousness. But refusing to take glass AT ALL and telling us to take it to a depot in Campbell River or else throw it in out garbage is approaching a Lewis Carroll level of madness.

Glass is one of the easiest materials to melt and re-use. Even better, would be a policy requiring all manufacturers to take back their empties and refill them. I worked in a soft drink plant as a teen and we brought back empties in the delivery trucks and did exactly that. Every other glass producer should be required to do this.

This is a time when we need to be more progressive in our recycling policies, not throw more and more material into landfills.

I would like to know what kind of thought process went into creating this course of action.

I will also be starting a campaign to get people to leave their glass in your bins regardless of your mistaken policy.
